Admission Qualification:

Candidates must have passed (in one sitting) SSLC/HSLC/ICSE Examination or Equivalent Examination from any recognized Board of School Education in India.

Candidates securing less than 45% marks (for SC, ST, OT Category) and 55% marks (for General Category) in any of the subjects in SSLC/HSLC/ICSE Examination or Equivalent Examination need not apply and such candidates will not be considered in the merit list for allotment of seats for admission to Diploma course in Engineering/Technology. The allotment of seats will be done as per the merit marks subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria of the concerned Institutions where the seats are reserved.

Non-Tribal students should furnish P.R.C. issued by the competent authority without which their application will not be entertained.

I.P.O. issued before **27th July 2022** will not be entertained.
